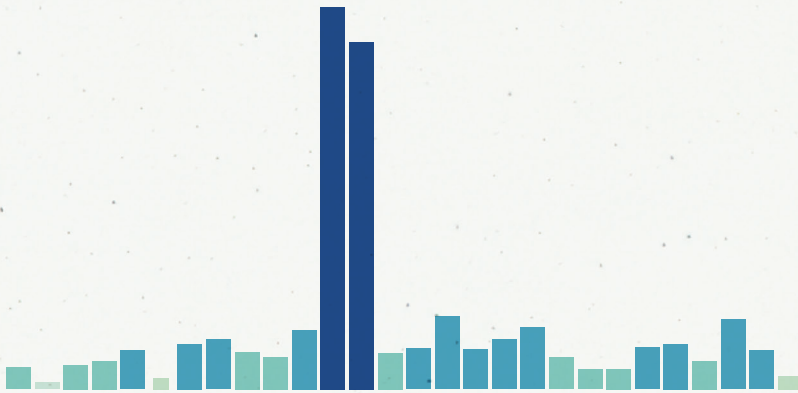


Conflict Declined by 50% Near Chinese Projects

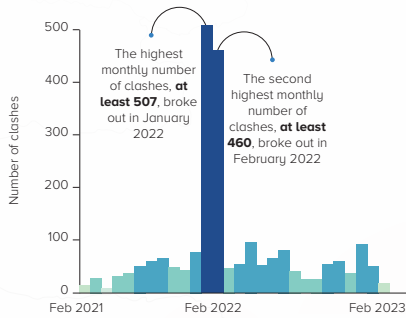


Within a span of two years between the coup and May 31, 2023, **at least 2,248** clashes occurred in **61** townships where China-Myanmar Economic Corridor (CMEC) projects are set to be implemented or where other Chinese projects are already underway. Of these 2,248 clashes, **at least 1,486** broke out within the first 14 months following the coup (from February 2021 to March 2022) while **at least 762** clashes broke out in the subsequent 14-month period (from April 2022 to May 2023). The comparison of the two different 14-month periods indicates that clashes declined by more than half.

■ Conflict Declined by 50% Near Chinese Projects

Within a span of two years between the coup and May 31, 2023, **at least 2,248** clashes occurred in **61** townships where China-Myanmar Economic Corridor (CMEC) projects are set to be implemented or where other Chinese projects are already underway. Of these, **1,486** clashes broke out between February 2021 and March 2022. **762** clashes broke out between April 2022 and May 2023. Therefore, clashes declined by more than half (50 percent) comparing the two 14-month periods.

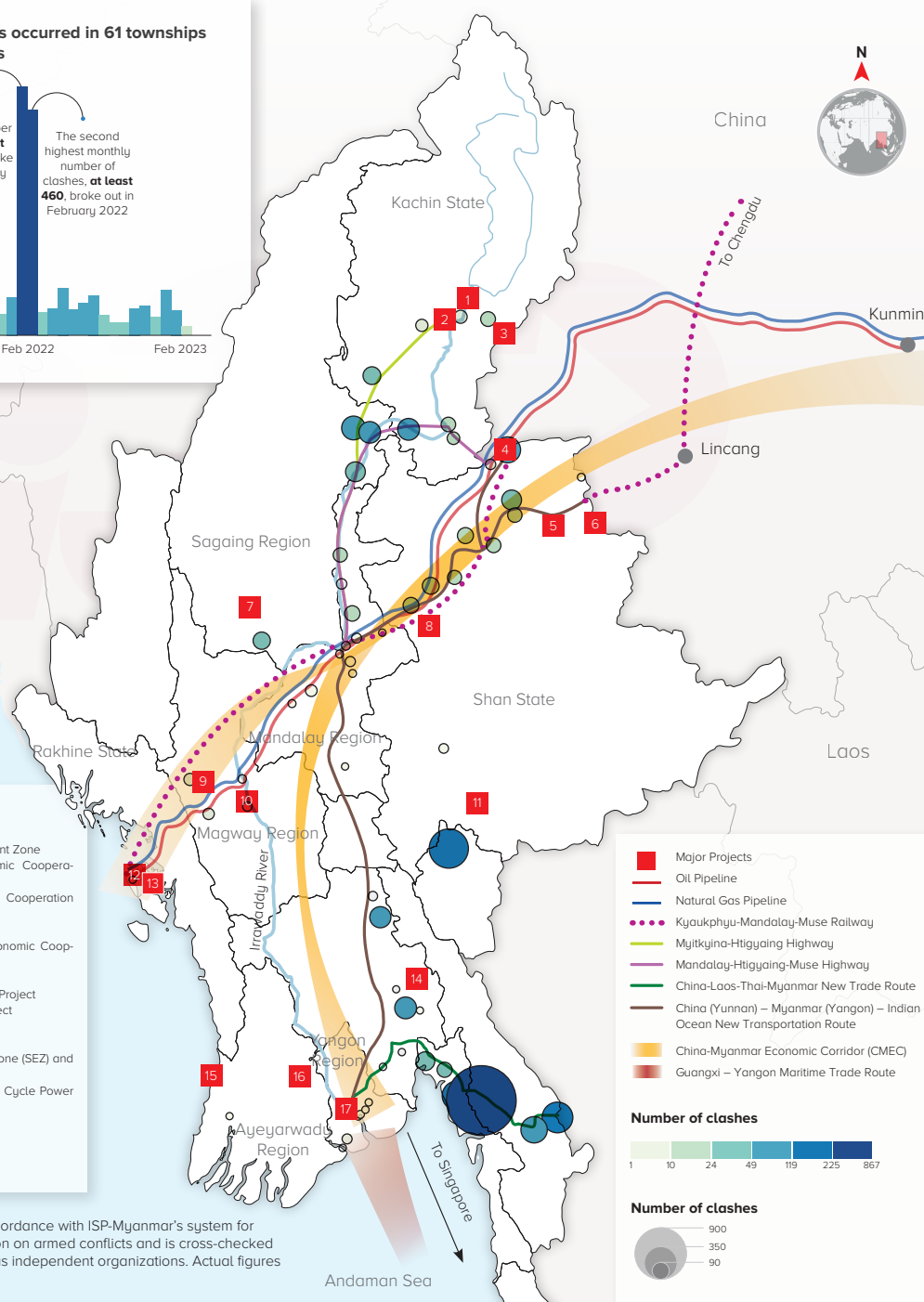
■ At least 2,248 clashes occurred in 61 townships with Chinese projects
