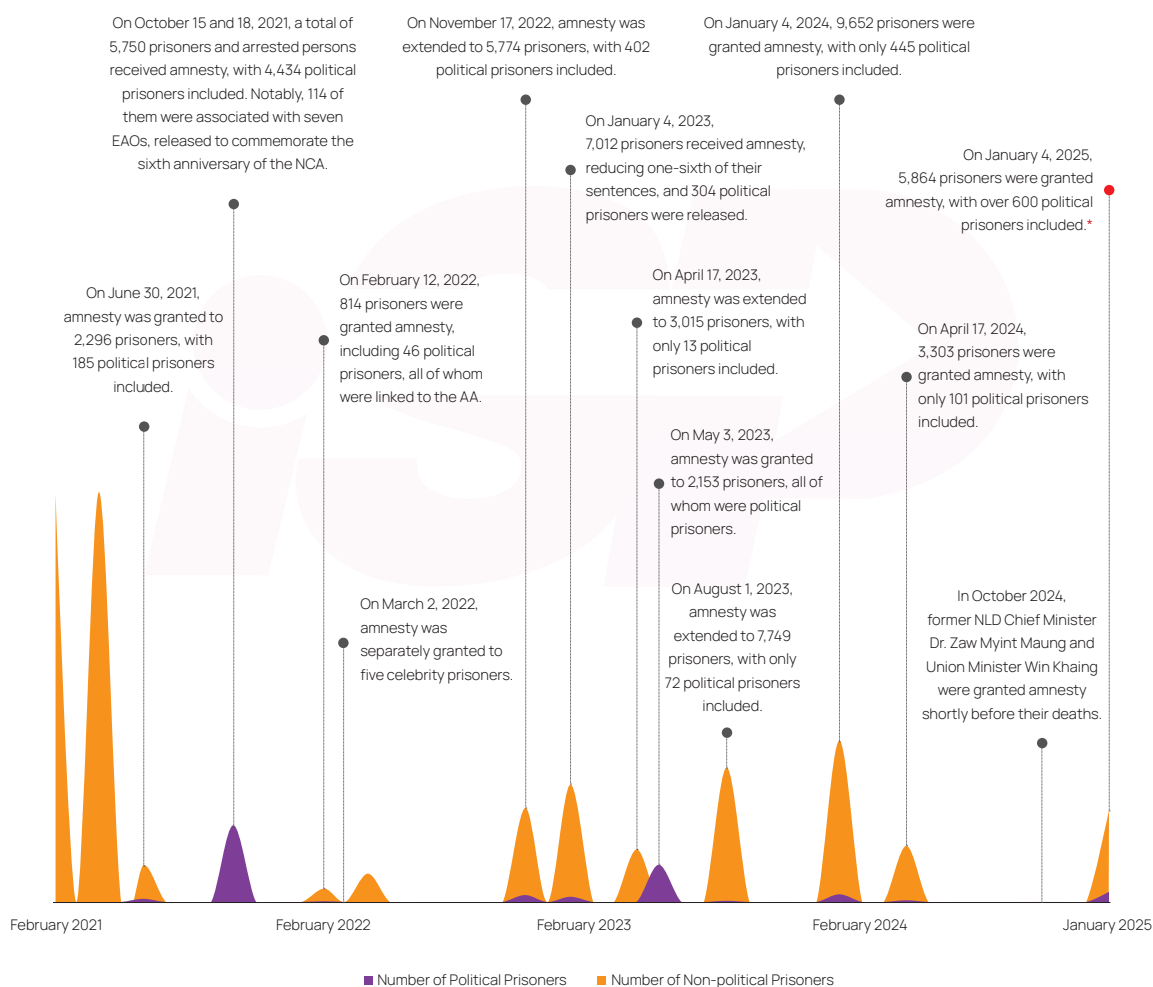


■ Political Prisoners Made Up 8.6 Percent of 16 Amnesties

(February 2021 to the first week of January 2025)

Throughout nearly four years of the coup, the State Administration Council (SAC) granted **16 amnesties**, releasing **101,729 detainees**. Among those released, **8,762** were political prisoners, making up **8.6 percent** of the total. Presently, **over 21,499** individuals are still detained for protesting against the coup, and **more than 9,958** have received prison sentences that range from **one year to the death penalty**.

Note: This data was collected by ISP-Myanmar's system for documenting information in armed conflicts and has been cross-checked with reports from various independent organizations, including the Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) and Political Prisoners Network Myanmar (PPNM). Due to data access limitations and on-ground situations, actual data may vary.

* The count of political prisoners released is based on figures announced by the SAC. As of January 6, 2025, initial reports from independent organizations show that only over 344 political prisoners released have been accounted for.
